Before beginning to implement strategies to make your office a 100% voting workplace, it is important to meet with the decision-makers in your office who can best decide if this is an activity that can become an official commitment at your workplace.

Here are some strategic questions to consider as you move forward a plan to become a 100% voting workplace:

1. Do you have a flextime policy in your office?
 - You may wish to work with the decision makers in your office to ensure there can be a flextime to allow people to vote without causing issues at work.
2. Are there people in your office who have the same polling location? If so, consider coordinating carpooling to the polls.
3. Could your office incentivize workers to achieve the 100% voting goal with an office party or drawing?
4. Is there an office bulletin board where people can post their "I Voted" stickers to celebrate their follow-through on their commitment?



If the decision makers at your workplace do not wish to participate in the 100% voting workplace pledge, there are other things you can discuss with them to make voting and engagement easier on Election Day. You can advocate with the decision-makers in your work place for flextime for Election Day even if your office cannot participate as a 100% voting workplace.
