On July 4, 2025, President Trump signed into law the **Republican budget reconciliation bill**. This law takes away our health care, food, safety, and more.

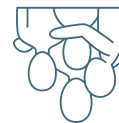
How The Big Bad Budget Law Hurts Our Communities

The majority of Americans, **across parties**, oppose it.

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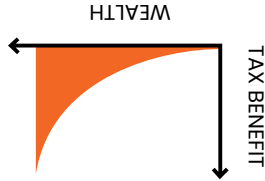


- How this law hurts us**
1. **It guts Medicaid** - Kicking 17 million of us off our health insurance, forcing nursing homes & hospitals to close, And raising care costs for everyone.
 2. **It gives ICE billions to raid our neighborhoods**, separate families, and abduct our loved ones and coworkers.
 3. **It guts SNAP** - worsening hunger for 40 million people.

4. **It hands \$1 trillion in tax giveaways to the richest 1% -** and leaves us with crumbs.
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5. **It worsens child poverty** - locking 19 million kids out of the Child Tax Credit.
 6. **It hikes our utility bills** by repealing nearly all clean energy tax credits.

- Some things go into effect immediately; **Medicaid cuts may not be felt until 2027.**
 - The law's "benefits" - like tipped income tax exemption and saving accounts for kids - **expire by 2029.**
 - But, the law's drafters made sure to set tax handouts for the ultra-wealthy as **permanent.**
