Setting the Moral Frame

- Our call to protect creation is rooted in the **Catholic Social Justice tradition**:
 - Care for Creation safeguarding God's gift for all people; living in right relationship
 - Solidarity coming together, especially with frontline and Indigenous communities, to act
 - Option for the Poor protecting those most affected by climate injustice and looking to them for solutions

Big Picture

- Whether we live in the city, the suburbs, or a rural area, we all deserve safe water, breathable air, and affordable clean energy.
- Yet, some in Congress and the Administration continue to roll back our protections and give polluters a free pass—inflating their profits at our expense.
- People of faith continue to come together to protect our neighborhoods, our lands, and our futures!

An Economy for All is a clean energy economy.

Department of Energy Rollbacks

Recent actions:

- Canceled \$13B in renewable energy project funding
- Ended incentives for wind and solar development
- Promoted fossil fuel expansion under the guise of "energy independence"

Impacts:

- Threatens clean energy job growth
- Slows U.S. transition to a renewable future
- Increases carbon emissions and pollution

Department of the Interior (DOI) Rollbacks

Recent actions:

- o Opened millions of acres of public lands for oil and gas leasing
- Reduced environmental review requirements under NEPA
- Weakened tribal consultation standards

Impacts:

- Threatens sacred lands and cultural heritage
- Undermines community voices in decision-making
- Exacerbates climate and biodiversity crises

Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Rollbacks

Recent actions:

- Rolled back PFAS and petrochemical regulations
- Delayed enforcement on corporate polluters
- Weakened Clean Water Act protections

Impacts:

- Increased toxic exposure, especially in frontline areas like Cancer Alley
- Shamyra Lavigne-Davey: Faith-led resistance and the power of local action
- "Our water is sacred. Protecting it is both a moral and spiritual duty."

Legislative Overview

- Congress faces two choices:
 - PERMIT Act (H.R. 3898) Weakens environmental review and silences communities
 - Fix Our Forests Act (S.1462) Protects forests, supports wildfire recovery, and invests in resilience
- NETWORK's position:
 - o PERMIT Act: **OPPOSE**
 - Fix Our Forests Act: SUPPORT

The PERMIT Act (Oppose)

What it does:

- Limits public comment under NEPA
- Fast-tracks fossil fuel projects
- Weakens environmental justice safeguards

Why we oppose it:

- Silences communities most affected by pollution
- Prioritizes corporate interests over public health
- Undermines decades of environmental law

The Fix Our Forests Act (Support)

What it does:

- Strengthens wildfire resilience and restoration
- Provides funding for reforestation and prescribed burns
- Allows for speeding up of essential forest restoration projects
- Creates a nationwide system to designate the top 20% of wildfire-exposed landscapes for treatment
- Creates a wildfire intelligence center for wildfire data, modeling, smoke forecasting, and decision support
- Increases capacity for growing and planting trees to restore burned or degraded lands
- **Bipartisan support:** Passed the House with support from both parties (279-141) with 64 Democrats voting in favor
