Re: Interfaith Partners Urge Congress and the White House to Immediately Return to Negotiating Table and Work to Protect the American People

Dear Majority Leader Thune, Minority Leader Schumer, Chair Collins, Ranking Member Murray:

We, the undersigned interfaith communities and organizations, write today to urge Congress and the White House to immediately return to the negotiating table to develop a bipartisan solution that ends the shutdown, funds the government, and ensures Congress' appropriations decisions are adhered to. Equally urgent is our call for Congress and the Administration to immediately resolve the food insecurity and healthcare insecurity crises impacting 42 million people who use Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits, and 24 million Americans currently enrolled in the Affordable Care Act Marketplace.

The inability of this country's elected officials to negotiate a resolution to the current impasse is deeply impacting federal workers. Hundreds of thousands of them have been put on leave or forced to work without pay. These workers provide essential roles in our communities, such as keeping our food, water, and public transportation methods safe. They respond to natural disasters, care for our veterans, process Social Security applications, and more. Yet, they continue to face indignity from our government. In a move that a federal judge said was likely to be found illegal, the Trump Administration has fired hundreds of thousands of workers--and more are threatened to be fired--if the shutdown is not resolved according to their wishes.

This shutdown threatens human dignity and our democratic system. Congress must exercise its constitutional authority over the power of the purse and its responsibility to serve the needs of the people. Over the past fiscal year, the Trump Administration has repeatedly undermined Congress' constitutional authority over the power of the purse--rescinding and acting with questionable legality to withhold funds for a wide range of programs. Congress must ensure this playbook is not repeated in order to protect critical programs and the vital checks and balances that our democratic system relies on.

The most vulnerable people in our communities across the country are undoubtedly bearing the brunt of this shutdown. This pain will only accelerate as funding reserves dry up for important programs. Three weeks into the shutdown with no end in sight, the Trump Administration has indicated that programs such as SNAP, Head Start, federal rental assistance, and food for women and children will soon run out of funds. And out-of-pocket health insurance premiums for 24 million Affordable Care Act Marketplace enrollees have skyrocketed, affecting every congressional district, such as, WV-02 which is up 599%. Nearly five million Americans are expected to lose insurance immediately because they cannot afford these dramatic pricing increases. None of these outcomes are acceptable.

The framers of the U.S. Constitution laid forth the basic purpose of our government during the hot Philadelphia summer of 1787: *government's responsibility--your mission as elected officials--is to promote justice and the general welfare, seeking always to become a more perfect union.* This calling is as important today as it was then.

These issues must be resolved immediately. Every day this shutdown continues to harm our people. Congress and the Trump Administration must negotiate a path forward which opens the government, fixes the health crisis, and protects federal workers. We sincerely urge you to return to the negotiating table and develop a bipartisan solution that ends the shutdown by funding the government, addressing the healthcare and food program funding crises, and ensuring Congress' appropriations decisions are adhered to.
