Re: Interfaith Partners Urge Congress to Extend the Enhanced Affordable Care Act Premium Tax Credits NOW to Protect the Health of the American People

Dear Majority Leader Thune, Minority Leader Schumer, Speaker Johnson, Minority Leader Jeffries,

We, the undersigned interfaith communities and organizations, write today to urge you to immediately address the health care crisis unfolding across the United States for 24 million Americans seeking health coverage through the Affordable Care Act (ACA) for next year. Congress must keep costs down for working families and pass a bipartisan bill that protects and expands enhanced ACA premium tax credits before the December recess.

All faith traditions value the preservation of human life as their highest moral value. As such, each life is sacred and, therefore, there is a moral imperative to provide care for the sick and alleviate suffering particularly for those who lack resources to pay. Health care cannot be a privilege only for the wealthy. Justice demands action now to ensure that 24 million Americans have the health care they need to live and thrive, as people are currently making choices about coverage for 2026.

Congress can keep our healthcare premiums from skyrocketing for families struggling to put food on the table and a roof overhead. Without the enhanced ACA enhanced premium tax credits, the cost of healthcare coverage on the ACA Marketplace will spike by an average of 114% for 24 million people. Data shows that 4.8 million people will lose coverage in 2026 because they cannot afford it without assistance. And studies show that without coverage, 50,000 people may lose their lives next year.

Our communities pleaded for an extension of these credits as part of the Budget Reconciliation process earlier this year. Our moral calls were denied. We insisted that the credits be part of the continuing resolution solution. Our request was again rejected. Now, in the closing days of this year--with millions trying to sign up for coverage, we demand you find a solution to this preventable healthcare crisis.

As elected public servants, you enter a covenant with the people to promote the common good. Every crisis is compounded by choices made and not made. The choice to deny humanity, dignity, and justice to others--whether through active harm or passive neglect--is a moral failure. We call on each of you to meet this moment with compassion and courage to pass, protect and expand the enhanced ACA premium tax credits immediately.
